

Competitor Match Information Handbook

















Safety First!!!

The primary responsibility of the Range Officials is the safety of competitors, spectators and fellow Range Officials; with the efficiency and speed of the competition as secondary factors. Every competitor and spectator attending this match must follow safety directions from Range Officials at all times.

Hearing and Eye Protection

Competitors and spectators attending this competition must wear hearing and eye protection at all times while shooting is in progress.

Designated Safety Areas

APC has three Safety Areas. These are located at the back of each range.

The uncasing or casing of firearms must always take place in the Safety Area unless under the direct supervision of a Range Officer at the firing line. Once holstered or cased, firearms may not, under any circumstances, be handled in any fashion outside the Safety Area without the express authorization of a Range Officer.

These areas are provided so shooters may check their firearm without being supervised by a Range Officer. You are also allowed to practice dry firing, reloads (as long as no ammunition is handled), and other activities such as repairs, cleaning, and maintenance provided you do so sensibly and safely.

Under NO circumstance may ammunition, loaded magazines, empty cases, practice ammo or snap caps be handled in the Safety Areas.

Match Disqualification

Any shooter DQd during the course of the match will not be permitted to shoot again for the duration of the match.

Registration begins at the range at 8:00 am on match day.

All competitors and visitors must sign the range register upon arrival at the range.

You must have completed registration and paid your entry fee prior to match day to be permitted to shoot the match.

During registration you will be issued with your competitor number, squad number, match handbook and score sheets. It is YOUR responsibility to check that your division, power factor, category and grade details are correct PRIOR to the match.

Match Briefing


The match briefings will start on Saturday 18th and Sunday 19th of July at 9:30 am on Range 1 prior to commencement of the day's shooting.

It is essential for all competitors to attend this briefing to ensure that everyone is aware of any information pertaining to issues or changes that may affect the match prior to the start of shooting.

Squad Leaders and ROs will be briefed separately about the day's stages prior to shooting.

Please note that all ranges, decking and covered areas at Auckland Pistol Club are smoke free.

Smoking is permitted in the car park area. If you choose to smoke please show consideration when disposing of your butts.

First Aid

Any person requiring first aid should be directed to their Squad Leader in the first instance or one of the other Match Officials.

A first aid kit is located in the clubroom by the main door and a telephone is also available in the club room should emergency services be required.

Refreshments

Drinks:

Tea and coffee are available free in club room anytime throughout the match and soft drinks and bottled water will be available for purchase.

Lunch:

Lunch will be provided both days for competitors and is included in the match fee.

Snacks:

A coin-operated vending machine is located in the club room.

A variety of candy bars and chippies are available for anyone who needs a quick energy boost during the course of the match.

Additional refreshments may also be available at the end of each day's shooting.

Toilets

Please only use the portaloos located in the carpark area during the competition.

The toilets in the clubroom are only for ladies use and range staff for the duration of the match.

Secure Firearms Storage

Safe offsite storage is available by prior arrangement for competitors who have travelled to attend the event and require their sporting firearms to be stored securely on their behalf when not being used.

Range Etiquette

Please treat your squad ROs with respect and listen to their directions at all times. The ROs are there to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable experience during the match.

Please keep the range clean and tidy. There are bins located all over the range complex for your convenience so please use them.

Please limit your walk-thrus to the three minutes prior to the start of the stage or when you're the next shooter.


There is nothing more annoying than trying to score, patch and pick up brass around some person who is blocking the road and is still several shooters away.

Unless you're the next shooter on the line, in the hole, or organising your gear directly after shooting then make sure you do your part and help your squad with scoring, patching and picking up brass.


Working together as a team keeps the event flowing so we can finish on time and relax together afterwards to swap tales and refresh ourselves with a cold one.







Gun is loaded in box, all spare mags on belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On start signal engage all targets from within the demarcated area.

Pushing button on handlebars activates slider which is non-disappearing. Button can be activated at any time after the start signal.
